The registree of this ticket ("ticketholder") will be granted entry to the Sustainable Skies World Summit ("SSWS 2026") at Farnborough International Exhibition and Conference Centre on the following terms:

1. Following booking, the ticketholder will be sent their tickets via the e-mail provided. This is the ticket and must be printed and provided to gain access to SSWS.
2. The Organiser reserves the right to ask for photo ID prior to entrance to SSWS.
3. Tickets have no resale value and cannot be transferred, resold, exchanged or used for any commercial or promotional purposes whatsoever without the consent of the Organiser.
4. Tickets are valid for Sustainable Skies World Summit in 2026 only and any unused tickets cannot be exchanged.
5. At the Organiser's discretion SSWS 2026 or any part of it may be cancelled and/or rescheduled without notice to the ticketholder for any event which is beyond the Organiser's control. In these circumstances, the Organiser shall have no liability whatsoever to the ticketholder or any other person.
6. The Organiser may have to conduct security searches to ensure the safety of persons attending SSWS 2026.
7. The Organiser may confiscate and dispose of any items which they will regard as



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dangerous or hazardous, including but not limited to firearms, weapons, knives, flares, fireworks or drones.

8. No animals, except for assistance dogs will be admitted to SSWS 2026.

9. The Organiser will take photographs and video recordings of attendees during SSWS 2026 and may use these images for marketing purposes. If you do not wish your photo to be taken and or for these to be used by the Organiser please speak to a member of the Organiser's team on the day.

11. Organiser shall be under no liability whatsoever to the holder or any other person for any direct or indirect loss or damage (other than death or personal injury caused by the Organiser's negligence) sustained by the ticketholder whilst attending SSWS 2026.

12. No unauthorised trading is permitted within the SSWS 2026 venue or any official car parking facility.

13. If the ticketholder is in breach of any of these terms and conditions, the Organiser may refuse the ticketholder entry or remove them from SSWS 2026. The Organiser may also remove persons from the premises where it is in their opinion necessary for public safety. No admission or readmission is permitted after the removal.
